- If English is not your first language, please submit a current official certificate demonstrating your English language skills: B2 level / IELTS 6.0 overall (with 6.0 in reading and writing, 5.5 in listening and speaking) / TOEFL from 72 overall (with 18 in reading, 17 in writing, 17 in listening and 20 in speaking). We might also be able to consider other alternative qualifications.
- Evidence of your current German Language level if you have some previous skills. Please either upload an official document showing the current level **or** complete the sample test and send us a screenshot of your end result.
